



How to talk about memorable events at your examination



Describe a happy event of your life

You should say:

When it happened Where it happen What it was

and explain why this event is a happy event in your life.







Describe an important letter that you received.

You should say:

Who wrote it to you? What the letter was about? How you felt about the letter?

And explain why the letter was important to you.







Describe the best gift/ present you have received You should say:

What is the gift Who sent it to you When did you receive it

And explain why it was the best gift / present you have received ever








Describe one of your childhood memories

You should say:

- What is it
- When it happened
- How it affected you in your life

and explain why you still remember it







Describe a big public event that you have attended.

You should say:

- what it was
- when was it held and why
- what happened

and explain how you felt about being there







Describe your favorite Restaurant.

You should say:

- Where it is
- What it looks like inside and outside
- What kinds of foods they serve

What makes this restaurant so special to you and others













SIMPLE FUTURE

We use it to express:

- -offering help
- -promise
- -prediction

Future Tense: Will→ Form

Iffirmative: I will travel to Madrid in October

Interrogative: Will you travel by bus?

Negative: I will not travel - won't.

Will you trave, by train or by bus? I won't travel by bus I will probably navel by train



You're cold. I'll close the window. - offering help
I'll buy you a new dog. - promise

GOING TO FUTURE

Future Tense:Going to→ Form

Affirmative: I am going to travel

hypiane

Interrogative : Are you going to mavel?

by plane

gative: I am not going to travel by plane because I am

going to fly in a hot air



We use it to express:

- -intention
- -plan
- -something that is likely to happen

I'm going to be polite. - intention
He is going to start a diet. - plan
Look at the clouds!It is going to
rain. - likely to happen
