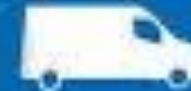

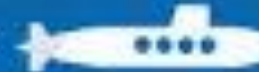

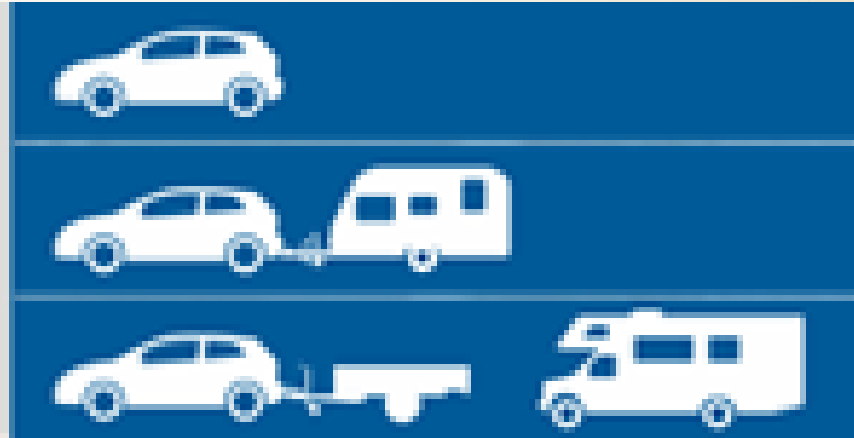

2 Motor Cars

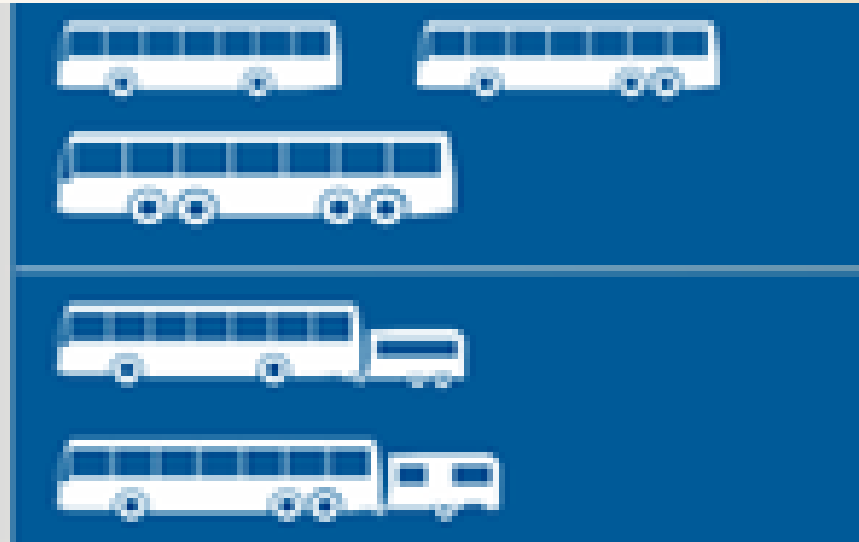


MOTOR CARS

Light Vehicle Cars including Campervan, MPV's (less than 8 passengers) and their effects. Taxi's, limousines, Light Vehicles towing a caravan or trailer with any number of axles

Buses or Coaches



BUSES or COACHES

Buses or coaches (any number of axles any size) with a capacity to carry 8 or more passengers

Light Goods Vehicles



Good Vehicles, (vans and any car with no rear window) and adapted for goods. No back seats. This includes car, vans, jeep type with back windows paneled out, seats removed and all pick up types included. Whether in the course of trade or otherwise
