



<b>SIMPLE FUTURE</b> I/WE/YOU/SHE/HE/THEY <b>WILL READ</b> THE BOOK TOMORROW.	<b>FUTURE CONTINUOUS</b> I/WE/YOU/THEY/HE/SHE <b>WILL BE READING</b> THE BOOK SOON.
<b>FUTURE PERFECT</b> I/WE/YOU/SHE/HE/THEY <b>WILL</b> <b>HAVE READ</b> THE BOOK BY NEXT WEEK.	<b>FUTURE PERFECT CONTINUOUS</b> I/WE/YOU/SHE/HE/THEY <b>WILL</b> <b>HAVE BEEN READING</b> THE BOOK FOR FIVE DAYS <b>BY MONDAY</b> .
