Common Mistakes





- I'm planning **to travel** to Peru. ✓
- I'm planning **a trip** to Peru. ✓
- I'm planning ~~a travel~~ to Peru. ✗

TRAVEL **VERB**
ACTION

MEANING:
To go from one place to another, especially over a long distance.

- I like to travel by plane.
- Mary travels to Italy once a year.

TRIP **NOUN**
THING

MEANING:
Act of going to a place for a short period of time and returning.

- We went on a trip to the beach.
- John is on a business trip.

NOUN **TRAVEL**

MEANING:
The act/concept of travelling.
BUT don't say: ~~a~~ travel

- You should write about your travels.
- Travel broadens your mind.

EXCEPTIONS

TRIP **VERB**
with a completely different meaning

MEANING:
To stumble or almost fall while walking or running.

- I tripped in front of everyone.
- He tripped over the cat in the dark.
