# Topic 31:

## Adverbs of manner

**Adverbs of manner** are used to tell us the way or how something is done. An adverb can be added to a verb to modify its meaning.

"**She plays piano.**" - An adverb of manner can be added to the verb (play) to modify its meaning and give us more information on how she plays piano.

"**She plays piano beautifully.**"

"**She plays piano softly.**"

"**She plays piano terribly.**"

- James coughed **loudly** to attract her attention.
- He plays the flute **beautifully**. (after the direct object)
- He ate the chocolate cake **greedily**. (after the direct object)
