# Using Whatever – Whenever Wherever – Whichever – Whoever

#### Whatever

anything or everything; regardless of what

I will lend you whatever book you need.

Don't get upset whatever your father says.

#### Whenever

every time; regardless of when; at any time

You may come whenever you want.

Michael plays computer games whenever she is free.

#### Whoever

the person who; regardless of who

Whoever comes with you is welcome.

Whoever came late yesterday must stay after class today.

#### Wherever

everywhere; no matter where; regardless of where

Wherever he goes, he talks about him new house. Alex followed my father wherever he went.

#### Whichever

the person or thing which; no matter which; regardless of which

I will take two apples whichever you want.

Wear whichever shoes are the most comfortable.



#### However

Any way at all or It doesn't matter how

Example

However you look at it, it's going to cost a lot.



Anything at all or It doesn't matter what

Example

Whatever you do, try your best.



#### Whoever

Any person at all or It doesn't matter who

Example

Whoever made this cake is a real artist.

#### Whichever

Any one at all or It doesn't matter which

Example

Whichever day you come, we will be pleased to see you.

#### Whenever

Any time at all or It doesn't matter when

Example

Whenever I go to London I feel like a provincial.

#### Wherever

Any place at all or It doesn't matter where

Example

Wherever we are going, it doesn't matter as long as we're together.





WHATEVER

'anything' or 'it doesn't matter what'

We can do whatever we want now.

(=We can do anything, it doesn't matter what.)



WHICHEVER

'any one' (limited) or 'it doesn't matter which'

Use one of those two pillows, whichever you prefer.

(=Take any one of them. It doesn't matter which.)

WHENEVER

'at any time' or 'it doesn't matter when'

You can come whenever you want.

(=Come at any time. It doesn't matter when.)

WHEREVER

'to/at/in any palce or it doesn't matter where'

Leave it wherever you like.

(=Leave it in any place. It doesn't matter where.)

WHOEVER

'any person' or 'it doesn't matter who'

We have to find whoever did this.

(=It doesn't matter who did it. We have to find them)

HOWEVER

'in any way' or 'it doesn't matter how'

You can use the money however you like.

(=Use the money in any way. It doesn't matter how.)
