## Prefixes


A group of letters placed before the root word.

## Suffixes

A group of letters placed after the root word.

## **SUFFIXES IN ENGLISH**





**Suffixes** are placed after words to modify their meanings; like prefixes, they are groups of letters that rarely serve a purpose unless attached to a word.



SUFFIX	MEANING	EXAMPLES
-able/-ible	capable of being	portable, legible, preventable, adaptable
-ac/-ic	like/related to	cardiac, iconic, organic
-acy	state/quality of being	privacy, legitimacy, bureaucracy
-ious	full of	gracious, malicious, ambitious
-al	related to	logical, philosophical, bacterial
