WHAT IS A NARRATIVE ESSAY?


- A narrative essay is written in the form of a story and clearly gives a point of view on the subject-most often that of the author. The idea of this type of essay is to engage the reader in a sensory and emotional way which will allow them to connect with that is being written about.
- A narrative essay will use characters, plots and themes and may even include a dialogue. Each aspect of the narrative essay will revolve around the main point of essay-it's topic.



What is Narrative Essay?

- A narrative essay is a **story**.
- A narrative essay is a piece of writing that recreates an experience **through time**.
- A narrative essay can be based on one of your own **experiences**, either past or present, or it can be based on the **experiences** of someone else.
- In addition to telling a story, a narrative essay also **communicates a main idea or a lesson learned**.





Narrative essays are the ones that engage the reader the most. Numerous “I” sentences give readers the feeling that they are involved in the story.



A SAMPLE NARRATIVE ESSAY
