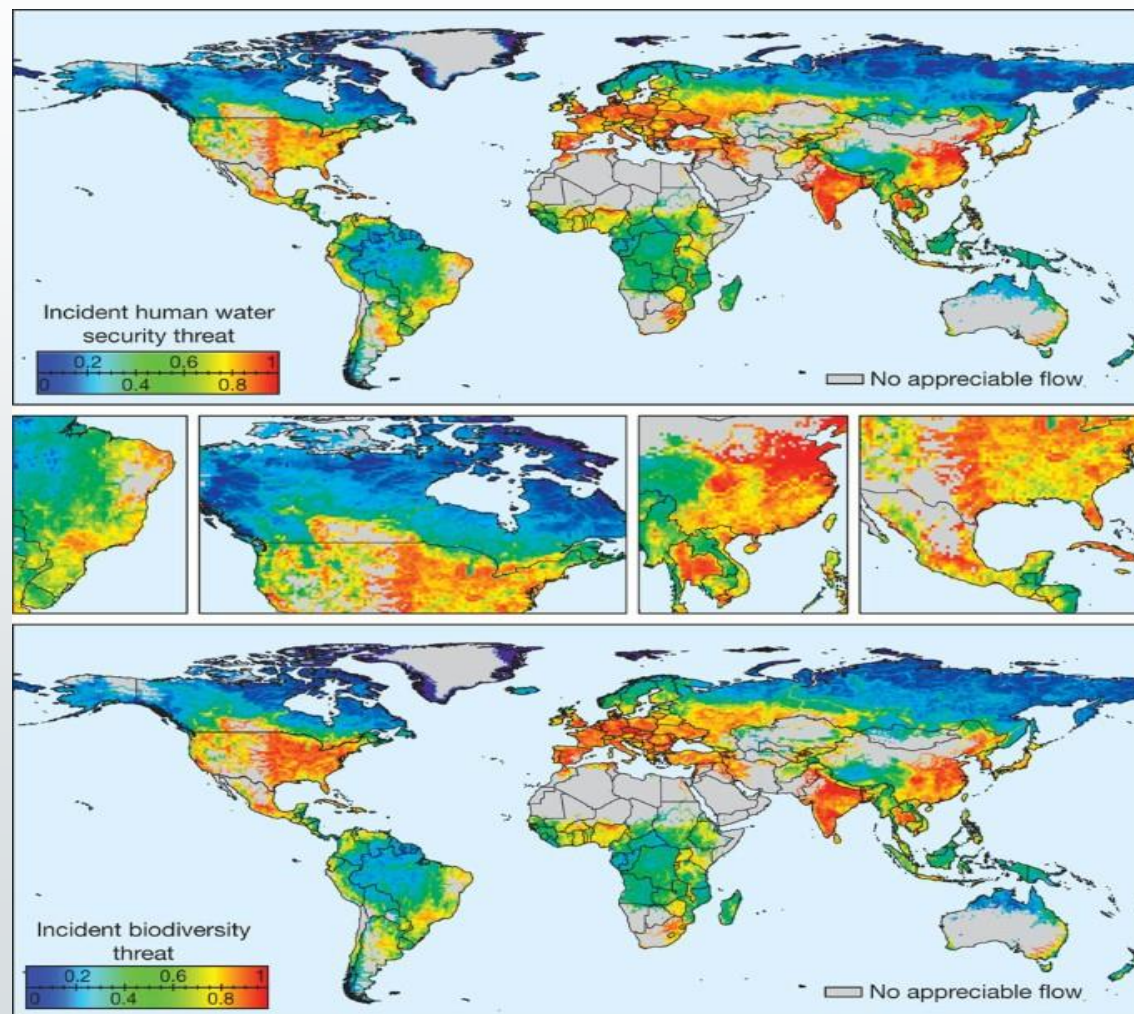
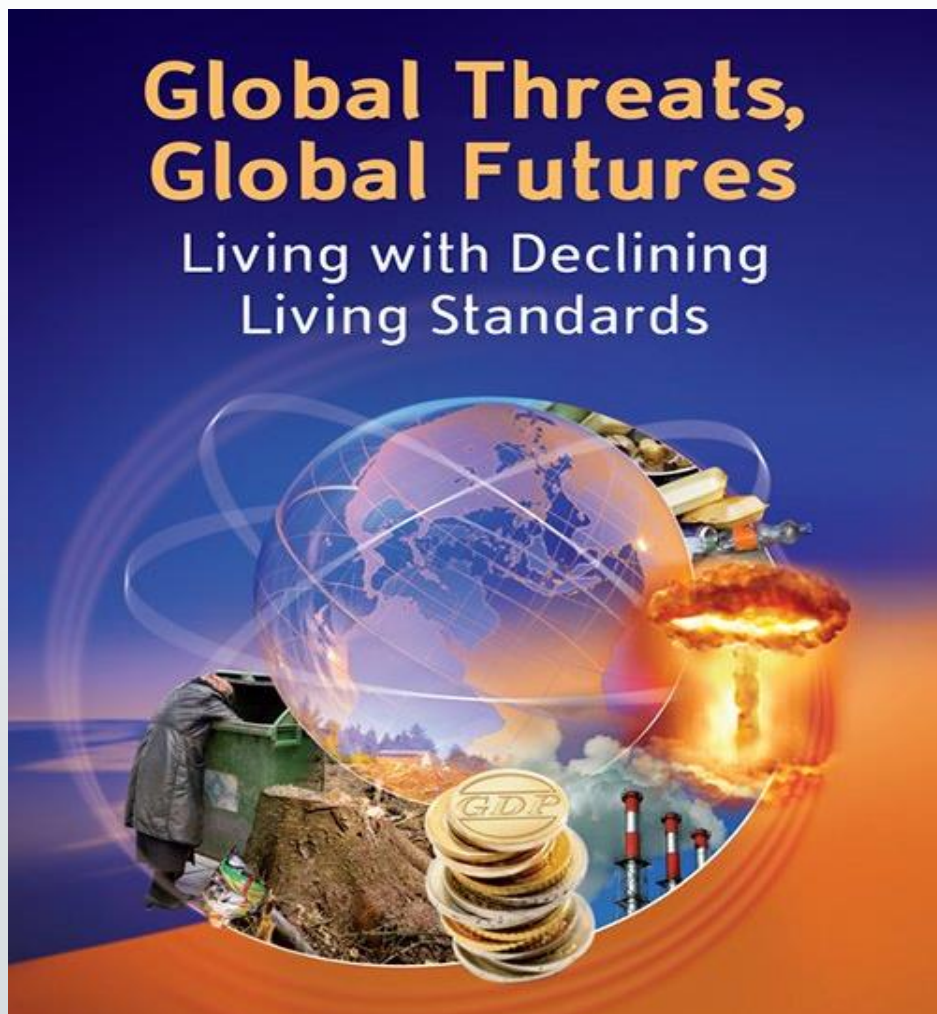

What are we most concerned about?

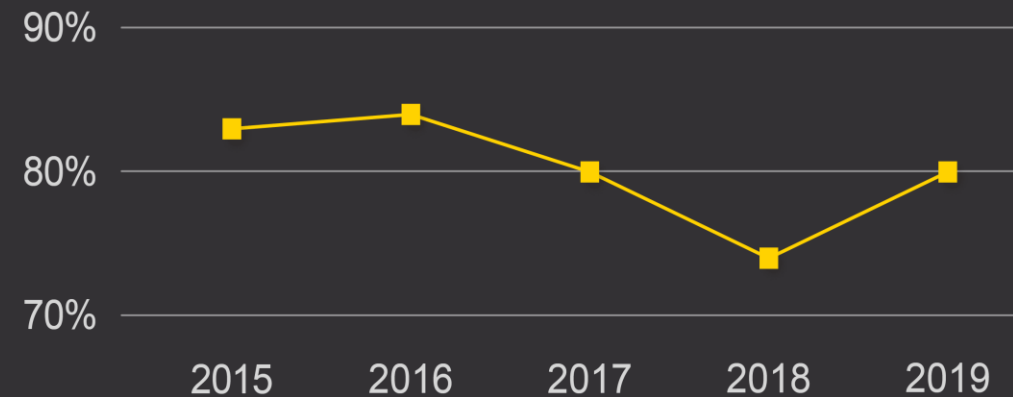


**75%**

How dangerous is our world?

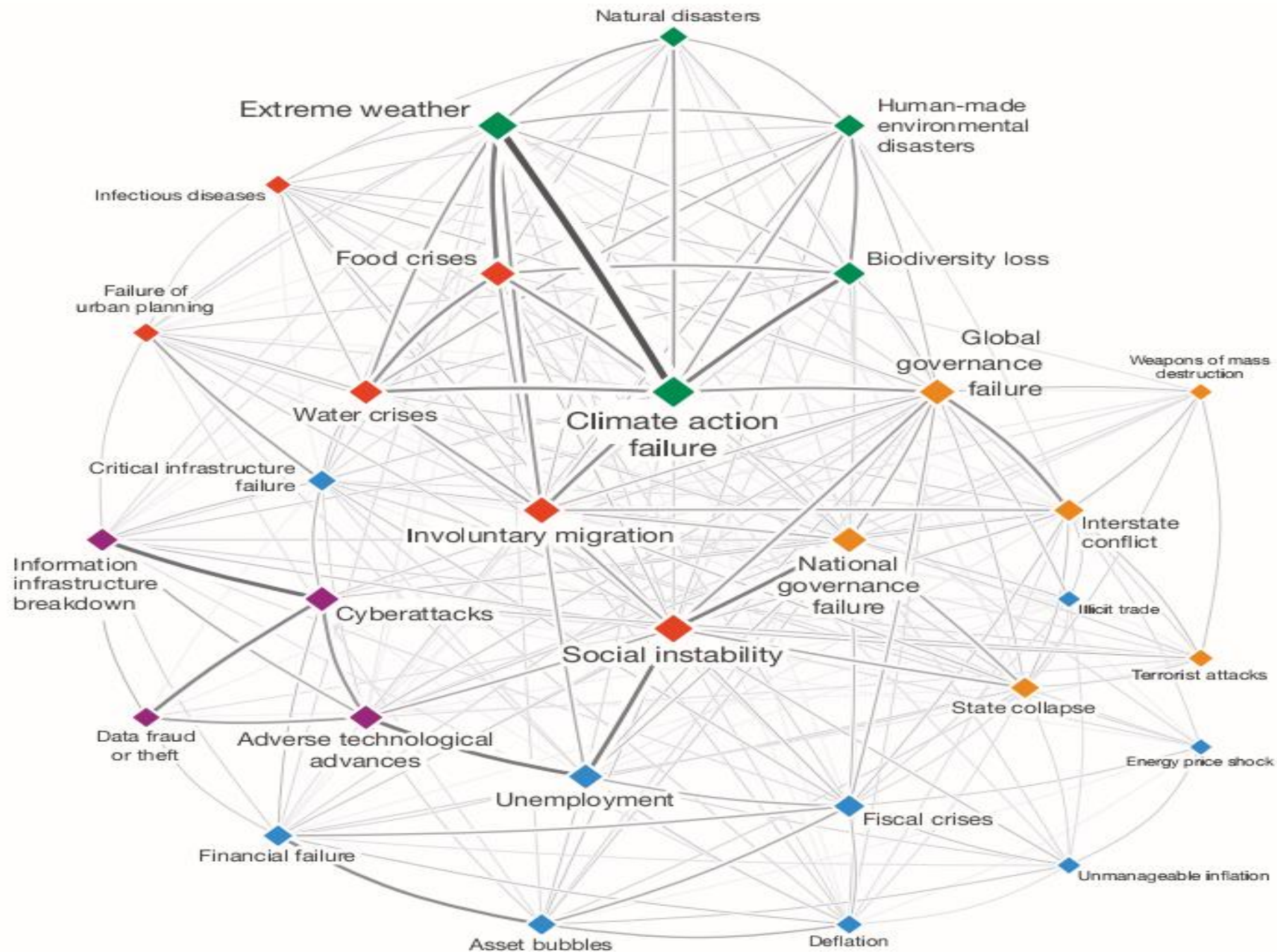


■ People that say world became more dangerous in past year

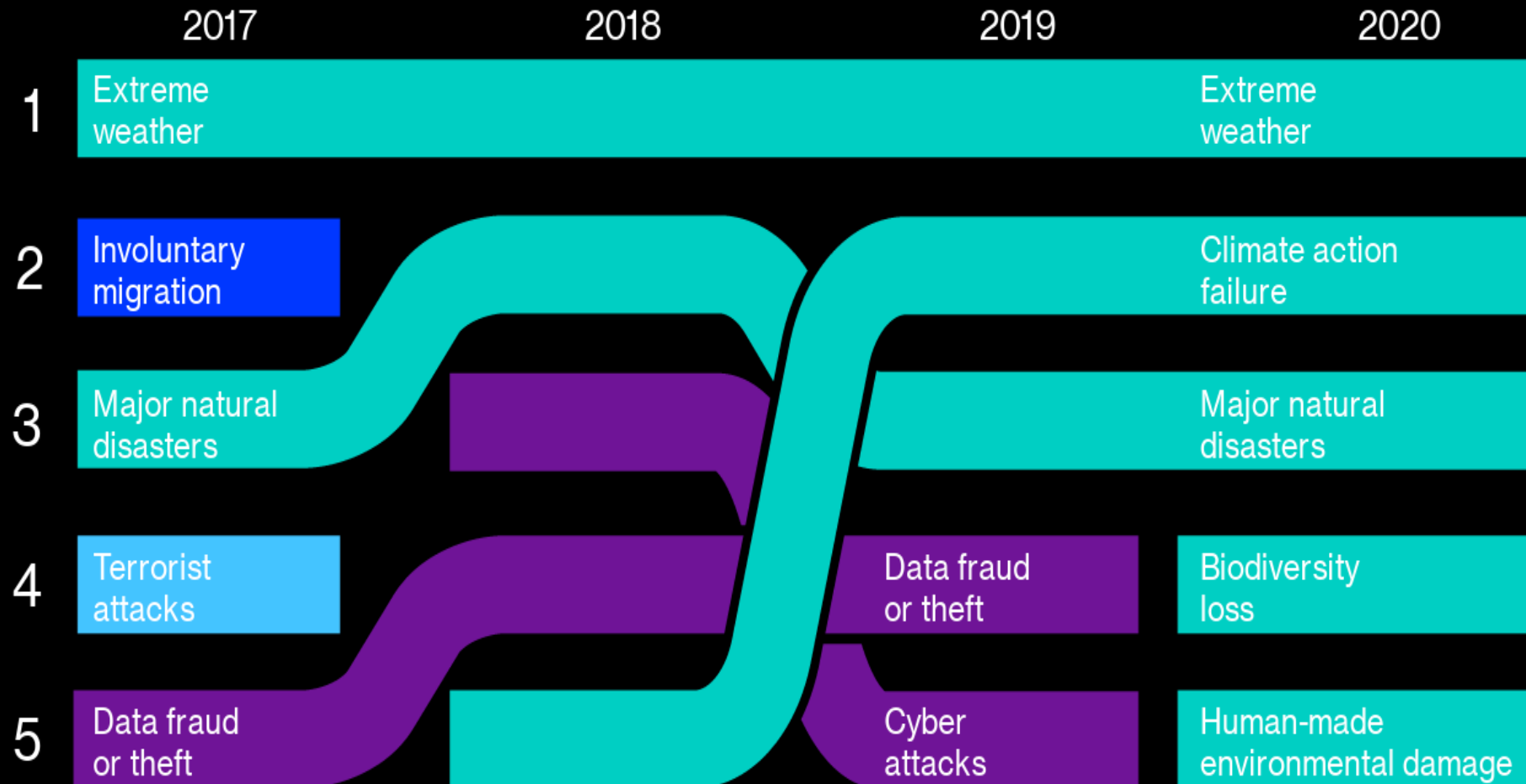
