# IMAGINARY SITUATIONS



## Wishes and Dreams

Using could as the past of can and were as a past of be.

Main clause + clause with the wish

(Subject + wish) + (subject + past form of verb)

I wish + I had more free time

We wish + we could afford to move.

I wish I was taller.

What does your mother / father wish for?

# IMAGINARY SITUATIONS

## Unreal situations

We use the unreal past to talk about things that are hypothetical, imagined or not real that are actually in the present or future. We introduce them with certain expressions:

*If, I wish, if only, supposing/suppose, it's time, I'd (would) rather, and what if.*

I wish I had a million pounds.

If only I were taller.

I'd rather you didn't talk so loud.

Suppose I won a million pounds. What would we do?

It's time we left. I'm feeling tired.

What if we caught a later flight? Then we could stay here longer.

If we went to the show tomorrow, we'd miss the crowds.

1. If i **was** taller, I **would** be a basketball player
2. If i **went** to japan, I **would** visit the coffin hotel
3. If i **had** a bigger house, I **would** invite all my class to my birthday party
4. If i **could** sing, I **would** be a famous opera singer
