The Passive Voice

- The Present Simple Passive am / is / are + V₃
- The Past Simple Passive was / were + V₃
- The Future Simple Passive will / shall +be + V₃





Passive: be + V ₃

Present simple	am / is / are + V3	is written			
Present continuous	am / is / are being + V3	are being written			
Past simple	was / were + V ₃	were written			
Past continuous	was / were being + V3	was being written			
Future simple	will be + V ₃	will be written			
Present perfect	have / has been + V3	has been written			
Past perfect	had been + V3	had been written			
Future perfect	will have been + V₃	will have been written			
Modals + infinitive	should / can / + be + V3	can be written			
Modals + perfect infinitive	should / can / + have been + V3	should have been written
