How to Make Comparatives and Superlatives

1 Single Syllable and Double Syllable Words ending with -y, -er, -ow, -le -



We use '-er' to make the comparative and '-est' to make the superlative.

POSITIVE	COMPARATIVE	SUPERLATIVE
Black	Blacker	Blackest
Fair	Fairer	Fairest
Clever	Cleverer	Cleverest

When there is a silent 'e' at the end of the positive form, we remove that and add '-er' and '-est'

POSITIVE	COMPARATIVE	SUPERLATIVE
Nice	Nicer	Nicest
Late	Later	Latest
Hate	Hater	Hatest
