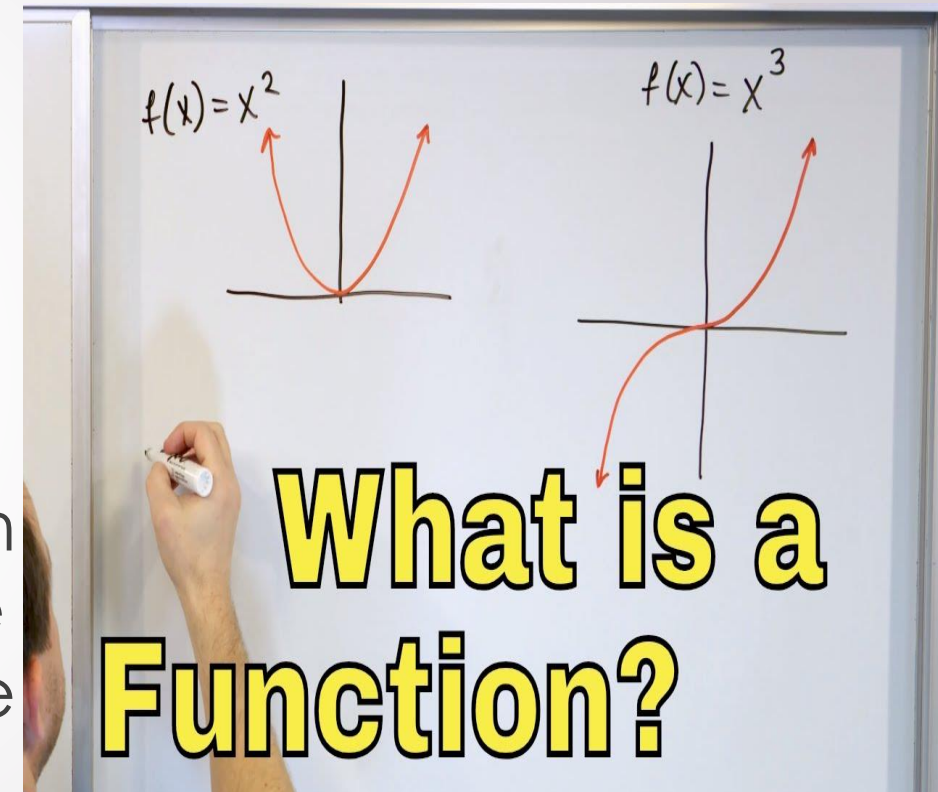
Form

- ▶ In a Type 3 conditional sentence, the tense in the 'if' clause is the past perfect, and the tense in the main clause is the perfect conditional or the **perfect continuous conditional**.

If clause (condition)	Main clause (result)
If + past perfect	perfect conditional or perfect continuous conditional
If this thing had happened	that thing would have happened.

Function

- ▶ The type 3 conditional refers to an impossible condition in the past and its probable result in the past.
- ▶ These sentences are truly hypothetical and unreal, because it is now too late for the condition or its result to exist.
- ▶ There is always some implication of regret with type 3 conditional sentences. The reality is the opposite of, or contrary to, what the sentence expresses.
- ▶ In type 3 conditional sentences, the time is the **past** and the situation is **hypothetical**.
